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Glenorie Public School Award System

Dear Parents/ Caregivers,

The Discipline Policy of Glenorie Public School has a positive reinforcement side to it which involves a tiered award system that you are very familiar with.

The system is as follows:-

10 Ironbark Awards	=	1 Bronze Certificate
3 Bronze Certificates	=	1 Silver Certificate
3 Silver Certificates	=	1 Gold Certificate
3 Gold Certificates	=	1 Pennant

All awards need to be collected by the child and brought into the School Office when they have the above numbers. **The student must actually hand in 3 certificates of the same level.** For example, we will no longer accept 10 Ironbarks + 2 Bronze Certificates; or 2 Silver Certificates + 2 Bronze Certificates + 10 Ironbarks.

The awards will then be entered into our computer system by date. We can see when your child is to reach their next award and we know exactly how many awards your child has received throughout their whole school career. We will not be relying on whether awards have been signed on the back.

Students who have returned their 10 Ironbark Awards will have their Bronze Award sent home via the classroom teacher. Students who are eligible for their Silver, Gold or Pennant Awards will receive those awards at the next Gold & Silver Assembly.

Please keep all Certificates in a safe place and always bring in your awards when you are eligible for your next one.

A Maths Medallion is presented once per term at Assembly to one child in each grade from Years Two to Six. These awards are given to the students who have had the best performance with their times tables.

Positive reinforcement and success belong hand in hand so please continue to encourage your children to be the best that they can be.
