



Thank you to the couple of Mum's that poked their head into the canteen last Friday and helped out!! Let's keep the spirit of helping alive.... CAN YOU HELP FOR an hour on a Friday morning? Did you know that helping for just an hour or so on a Friday morning helps significantly in the canteen. With the large orders received each Friday any additional helper would be amazing – just pop into the canteen and ask the coordinator if you can help in anyway before you leave the school.

Even with young children you could go to Woolworths and do the shopping or help stick labels on the bags to make the day a little bit easier for the volunteers staying longer that day.

Other important notes: Please take the time to talk to your children...

If your child's recess or lunch order contains cold/frozen food – they are required to take their labelled bag back to the canteen to collect it.

If your child's order is not in the lunch basket – encourage them to talk to the teacher handing out the orders that day and then if not found they need to go to the canteen to talk with the volunteers to sort it out. Please remind your children to use their manners when at the canteen – ALL our helpers are volunteers and deserve the respect from the students.

Uniform Shop

Due to <u>no one</u> coming forward to help in the uniform shop, the uniform shop will continue to open Monday 9am to 10am BUT uniforms will only be delivered to your child's class on a Thursday if ordered via Flexischools.

Also if you have any concerns or comments about any aspect of the GPS uniform, do not take it to the volunteers in the uniform shop. They are not there to listen to your concerns about design or school rules in relation to uniform. The P & C committee together with the school Principal determine the uniform requirements. If you have any comments come along to a P & C meeting to voice your concerns.
