Rude, Mean or Bullying.

All classes work on implementing this program throughout the year. The activities designed for teachers are used with students to help them learn and integrate behavioral definitions of rude, mean, and bullying. You can help at home be helping your child recognise the difference between:

Rude= inadvertently saying or doing something that hurts someone else.

Mean =purposefully saying or doing something to hurt someone once (or maybe twice)

Bullying = intentionally aggressive behavior, repeated over time, that involves an imbalance of power.
