#### **COVID-19 Update**

The NSW Premier announced that stay-at-home rules apply to all schools in Greater Sydney until at least 12:01 am 30 September. Parents and carers must keep children – across primary and secondary school – at home unless they need to be at school. Schools are open for any child that needs it.

Students will return to face-to-face learning in staggered cohorts while under stay-at-home rules. Students in Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 12 as well as those completing their HSC are prioritised. COVID-safe operations are maintained through high rates of staff and student vaccination, safe rostering, physical distancing, and minimised contact between students and staff.

Students will return to face-to-face learning with NSW Health-approved COVID-safe settings on school sites in the following order:

- from 25 October Kindergarten and Year 1
- from 1 November Years 2, 6 and 11
- from 8 November Years 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9 and 10.

Any staff member returning to school sites will be required to present evidence of 2 doses of vaccine.

From 8 November all students will return to face to face learning and online learning lessons will not continue.

#### The Tell Them From Me Parent feedback survey

This term, our school, like many others in the state, will participate in a Department of Education initiative: the *Tell Them From Me* Parent feedback survey. The *Partners in Learning* parent survey is for parents and carers of school students. It is designed to clarify and strengthen the important relationship between parents/carers and school by gaining insights into parent/carer and staff communication, activities and practices at home, and parent/carer voice on school support of learning and behaviour. We have asked some questions about the learning from home experience this year. The survey results help to build an accurate and timely picture that schools can use for practical improvements. It complements the student and teacher surveys.

#### How does it work?

Parents/carers take the survey online in their own time. The survey usually takes less than 15 minutes and is anonymous.



#### **Book Week August 22nd August-27th August**



#### **Click and Collect**

For those families wishing to have access to library books over the lockdown period, we are offering a 'click and collect' service for library books.

**Step 1 - BROWSE:** If students would like to get some ideas, they can access our school online catalogue via the OLIVER library homepage on their student portal.

**Step 2 - EMAIL:** Please send any library book requests to the school email glenorie-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au, with 'library click and collect' as the subject. Specific books titles may be requested if available, otherwise a similar title will be chosen. Please indicate in the email what genre of books to include in the selection, and/ OR the PRC level desired (K-2, 3-4 5-6). Books will be processed and packed each Monday, so requests should be submitted by Friday to be considered for the following week.

- Step 3 RECEIVE CONFIRMATION: Parents will receive an email when the books are ready for collection
- **Step 4 CALL AHEAD:** Call the school prior to arrival so that your book pack can be waiting for you.
- **Step 5 COLLECT:** We ask that parents use a QR code to enter the school and wear a face mask. Your book pack will be waiting for you in the office on the front counter.



This book has been designed to support the mental health and emotional wellbeing of younger children, their parents and families during the COVID-19 pandemic.


