Class Numbers

Student Reports

All staff have been busily compiling our student reports, which includes identifying their engagement throughout learning from home. Please be aware that the reports will again be in a simplified version, like that of Semester 1, 2020. Student reports will be issued on Wednesday, 15 December.

Day One 2022

At the start of next year, we must ensure that we account for the presence of each and every one of the 294 anticipated enrolments prior to formally placing students in their 2022 classes. This involves telephoning the parents of any students who do not attend on Day One. If families take extended vacations and wait until Monday February 1 to return to school, we will be unable to form our classes on Day One and students will be required to remain in their 2020 classes until such time that we account for the whereabouts of each anticipated enrolment. Our current enrolment profile should mean we can form classes on the Friday as long as we do not have excessive student absences.

COVID Changes for 2022

Fully vaccinated parents and carers will be allowed on site to support curriculum delivery, student wellbeing activities and school operations (for example reading support, canteens and uniform shop), or to attend essential meetings. Parents must check in using the school check-in, show proof of vaccination on entry to the school site and follow mask-wearing requirements.

Parents and carers must follow the school's advice regarding student drop-off and pick-up, which will usually require parents to remain off school sites at these times. We are not sure of the restrictions that may be revised going into 2022 but we will let you know as soon as they become available to us.

Join The Band

Dear Parents,

Enrolments are now open to students who wish to join the school band in 2022. See below for a basic overview of the program.

Band Program Structure

Rehearsal: students work together in a full band setting, generally before or after school (30-60min each week)

Tuition: students work in small groups at school to learn new skills, usually on the same day as rehearsal (30min each week)

Students attend both rehearsal and tuition (weekly) at school.

Regular practise at home (3-4 times a week) is essential.

Band Program Costs

Tuition Fees: small group tuition and band rehearsal costs \$195 (plus a \$10 resource levy) per term. Individual tuition costs extra and is not available at all schools.

Instrument: students require their own instrument. TSA sells quality new instruments or offers 'rent-to-buy' starting at \$43 per month.

Accessories: students are provided with a workbook on enrolment but may require other accessories, generally less than \$50 per year.


