School Attendance

All students in Kindergarten to Year 11 are required to attend school until Friday 16 December 2022, the last day of teaching for 2022. Prior to this date, students in all year groups should be engaged in meaningful work based on the curriculum and syllabus requirements.

If parents are seeking permission for their child to be absent from school for a period of time the <u>Exemption from School - Procedures</u> should be followed.

Parents are required to explain the absences of their children from school promptly and within seven days to the school. An explanation for absence must be provided to the school within 7 days of the first day of any period of absence.

Swimming Program

As mentioned in the expression of interest, this program was limited to 60 students. Letters of offer have now gone home to the first 60 students that returned the expression of interest form. All students should have paid by last Friday. Students on the waitlist have now been offered a place to fill these vacancies.

Does Your Child Need Medication at School?

The parents of any student requiring the administration of prescribed medication during school hours must sign a Prescribed Medication Form and notify the school of any possible side effects. Prescribed drugs must be stored in the office area, but children will be required to come to the office at the specified time and receive assistance to take their medication. A record of this administration is kept by the office personnel supervising the procedure.
