What if my child is absent from school?

Parents must provide an explanation to the school within 7 days of the first day of any period of absence. This can be done on our school App, on our convenient slips in the office or a note written to the teacher explaining why your child/ren missed school. If the school does not receive an explanation of the absence from the parents within 7 days, the office will send a letter to parents within 2 school days after the 7-day timeframe has elapsed. How does it work?


