COVID Updates

As part of the NSW Government's focus on minimising disruptions to teaching and learning, the department will continue to support the use of rapid antigen tests (RATs) for symptomatic testing until at least the end of Term 1. Your family received one pack of RAT tests on Monday, unless they have tested positive for COVID in the last month. You will need to continue to test your child if they show any symptoms, such as headaches, coughing, runny nose or generally feeling unwell or another family member has tested positive for COVID.

In line with the changes in the general community settings, the department's protocols for COVID-19 cases have changed.

- Positive COVID-19 cases should be reported to the school if they have attended school recently.
- Positive RAT results must be reported through the <u>Service NSW websiteExternal</u> <u>link</u> and <u>Service NSW app.External link</u> If you do not live in NSW but work in a NSW school, you must register your positive RAT result in line with your state or territory's local requirements and notify the school as soon as possible. Refer to the overview of positive RAT reporting guidelines by state and territory for more information.
- Positive RAT or PCR test results for all staff and students must be reported to the school.

- It is recommended that students and staff that return to school after recovering from COVID-19 do not
 - recovering from COVID-19 do not participate in rapid antigen testing for 8 weeks following release from self-isolation unless they develop new COVID-19 symptoms. This is due to NSW Health advice that people who have recovered from COVID-19 have a low risk of contracting it again in the following 8 weeks.
 - When a COVID case is reported in your child's stage, a letter will be sent home to that stage informing you of the stage having students testing positive for COVID in the past 7 days.

The parade will start at 12:05pm and a picnic lunch from 1:30pm. A note was sent home last week. Good news, parents can attend Easter hat parade and may stay for a picnic lunch. The Opportunity Class Placement Test will be held on Thursday 28 July 2022.

The application process for Year 5 opportunity class placement for entry in 2023 is about to begin.


