Online Guardians

The Online Guardians are an eSafety accredited business with over 20 years of experience in social networks and adolescent development. They've presented to over 300,000 people in the past decade and have helped parents and caregivers navigate the constantly evolving online landscape.

Two student sessions will be conducted for years 3-4 and 5-6. These sessions will provide students a clear snapshot of the current online climate and the predicament for students. It will highlight trends and safety issues relevant to their online experiences and provide guidance and education on important topics to enable our students to make the best decisions at this critical time. They will provide a 'debrief' session following the presentation to assist students with account changes, privacy settings and any queries.

A parent session will follow on Tuesday 14th November between 6-7pm in the school library. These sessions are incredibly interactive with many questions, stories, and explanations. The presenters highlight common parent requests for assistance and physically demonstrate how to set up mobile phones and WIFI with parental controls. They additionally have the experience to discuss a variety of other adolescent development issues that may be relevant to the audience.

We will be running the Best Start Program with our new Kindergarten students next year.

This will mean that our Kindergarten students will attend school over Thursday and Friday at hour intervals to be assessed, returning home after the completion of the assessment. This allows our Kindergarten teachers to administer the assessment to each student and assess their abilities before they begin Kindy next year.

We will let each 2024 kindergarten parent know after our orientation sessions are finished, the date and time that their child will attend the Best Start Assessment. All kindergarten Children will start together on Monday 5 Feb, when they will be placed in their classes for the year.



The Glenorie P&C are delighted to host a breakfast for all the teachers and Staff at Glenorie PS.


